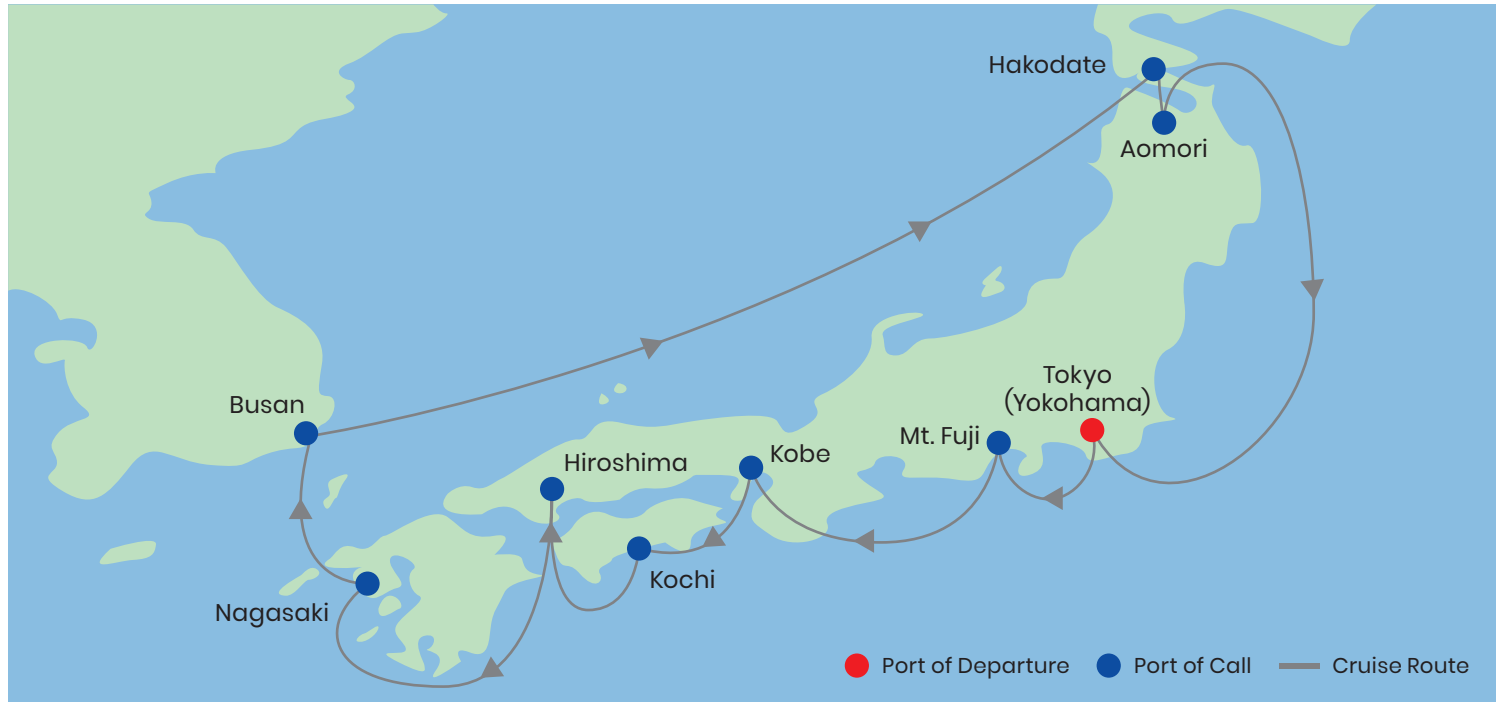

ITINERARY

DAY 1 – FRIDAY MAR 25, 2022

DEPART CANADA – TOKYO

You will be picked up from your home and transferred to Toronto Pearson Airport for your flight to Japan.

*Tentative flight: AC 1 25MAR YYZHND 130P 330P 26MAR
Note: Air schedule will be available 11 months prior to departure and flight details will be advised at a later stage.*

DAY 2 – SATURDAY MAR 26, 2022

HANEDA AIRPORT – YOKOHAMA (D)

Upon arrival in Haneda Airport, transfer to Yokohama hotel and enjoy the remaining day at leisure. Dinner at local restaurant.

Accommodation: 4 Yokohama hotel (1 night)*

DAY 3 – SUNDAY MAR 27, 2022

YOKOHAMA – PIER / EMBARKATION (B)

DEPARTS: 6PM

Enjoy breakfast at hotel in the morning and you will be transferred to Yokohama Port for embarkation after check out. Celebrity Solstice leaves Yokohama port at 6pm.

DAY 4 – MONDAY MAR 28, 2022

MOUNT FUJI (SHIMIZU)

DOCKED: 7AM TO 3PM

Arrive in Shimizu Port at 7am and pick up at pier for your half day tour at 8 am. Enjoy sightseeing near Japan's iconic Mt. Fuji, including a photo stop at Lake Ashi, and then continue to visit Mt. Komagatake with Komagatake's ropeway. You will be transferred back to Shimizu port at around 2pm and ship departs at 3pm.



DAY 5 – TUESDAY MAR 29, 2022

KOBE (L/D)

DOCKED: 9:30AM TO 11:59PM

Arrive in Kobe Port at 9:30am and pick up at 10:30am for your full day tour with lunch and dinner. Morning visit Todaiji Temple and Nara Deer park. The temple was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples of Japan and grew so powerful that the capital was moved from Nara to Nagaoka in 784 in order to lower the temple's influence on government affairs.

Afternoon we visit Nijo Castle, built in 1603 as the Kyoto residence of Tokugawa Iyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Period (1603-1867). Afterwards we visit Kyoto's most famous geisha district Gion for a walk, and then have dinner with Maiko performance in evening. Enjoy culture exchange with the performers, and feel free to dress up in Japanese costumes during dinner. You will be transferred back to Kobe port around 10pm and the ship departs at 11:59pm.

DAY 6 – WEDNESDAY MAR 30, 2022

AT SEA

DAY 7 – THURSDAY MAR 31, 2022

KOCHI

DOCKED: 7AM TO 5PM

Arrive in Kochi Port at 7am today and pick up from Kochi Port at 8am for your half day tour. We first visit the Hirome Market which is a facility loved by both Kochi Prefecture residents and tourist, and then we will visit the Kochi Castle, whose buildings have been designated by the national government as important cultural property. It is Japan's only castle where all the structures constituting its main building have been preserved. After visiting the Kochi Castle, we will head over to the Godaisan viewing point near the peak of Mt. Godai, located in eastern Kochi with an elevation of 146m, and enjoy a panoramic view of Urado Bay, Kochi Port, and downtown Kochi. You will be transferred back to Kochi Port at 1pm and the ship departs at 5pm.



DAY 8 – FRIDAY APR 1, 2022

HIROSHIMA (L)

DOCKED: 9AM TO 6PM

Ship will arrive in Hiroshima Port at 9am and you will be picked up at 10am to join a full day tour with lunch. We will first visit the Miyajima / Itsukushima Island, which is one of the most beautiful sites in Japan known for its forests, ancient temples/shrines, and famous for its giant torii gate which at high tide seems to be floating on the water. The sight is ranked as one of Japan's three best views. It is not only an UNESCO World Heritage Site but also designated as National Treasures by the Japanese government. Afterwards your journey continues to iconic landmarks including the Atomic Bomb Dome and the Hiroshima Peace Memorial park.

A tranquil spot covering over 120,000 square meters, it serves to memorialize the great many lives lost in the world's first nuclear attack, while making use of nature to reaffirm the preciousness of all life. You will be transferred back to pier at 5pm and ship departs at 6pm.

DAY 9 – SATURDAY APR 2, 2022

AT SEA

DAY 10 – SUNDAY APR 3, 2022

NAGASAKI

DOCKED: 7AM TO 5PM

Ship will arrive in Nagasaki Port at 7am and you will be picked up at 8am to join a half day tour. We will first make our way to Dejima, a man-made island constructed in 1636 to segregate Portuguese residents from the Japanese population and control their missionary activities. Today, Dejima is not an island anymore, as the surrounding area has been reclaimed in the 20th century. However, a number of Dejima's historical structures remain or have been

reconstructed in the area, including various residences, warehouses, walls and gates. Then we visit the Megane Bridge, one the most remarkable out of several stone bridges that span the Nakashima River in downtown Nagasaki. The bridge, which gets its name from the resemblance it has to a pair of spectacles when reflected in the river water, is a popular tourist attraction and is designated as an important cultural property. We continue to visit the Oura Cathedral, built towards the end of the Edo Period in 1864 by a French missionary for the growing community of foreign merchants in the city, it is considered the oldest standing Christian church in Japan. Lastly, we will visit Nagasaki Shinchi Chinatown, the oldest Chinatown in Japan and you will be transferred back to pier at 1pm. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city on your own and ship departs at 5pm.



DAY 11 – MONDAY APR 4, 2022
BUSAN, SOUTH KOREA (L)
DOCKED: 7AM TO 5PM

Ship docks at Busan Port at 7am today and you will be picked up at 8:30am to join your full day tour with lunch. Experience Busan's rich culture on this journey to the UN Memorial Cemetery. Established in 1951, the quiet park and cemetery honors a total of 2,300 United Nations soldiers representing 16 countries who were killed during the Korean War. Then we proceed to the Oryukdo Skywalk, a 15-meter glass bridge set up over a 35-metre high coastal cliff. Look under your feet to see the soaring coastal cliff and the rhythmic waves and feel like you are walking over the sky!

We continue to visit Haedong Yonggungsa Temple. Strategically set along the city's eastern coast, it is the perfect place to catch a spectacular view of the red sun rising through the horizon to brighten the day. Possible visit to BIFF square or Yongdusan Park after lunch and we proceed to Gamcheon Cultural Village. Formed by colourful houses built on the foothills of a coastal mountain in a staircase-fashion, it is affectionately nicknamed Korea's Machu Picchu or Korea's Santorini. You will be transferred back to Busan Port at 4:30pm and ship departs at 5pm.

DAY 12 – TUESDAY APR 5, 2022
AT SEA

DAY 13 – WEDNESDAY APR 6, 2022
HAKODATE (L)
DOCKED: 8AM TO 7PM

Ship will dock at Hakodate Port at 8am today, and you will be picked up at 9am to join a full day tour with lunch. We first visit the Motomachi Churches District which showcases a beautiful exotic townscape with Western-style buildings and Hachimanzaka Slope. We visit the observatory deck of the Goryokaku Tower which will give you a great overview of the city, and then take the Mt. Hakodate's Ropeway to get a spectacular evening view before returning to the ship. One way Hakodate Ropeway ticket is included. Transfer back to pier at 6pm and the ship departs at 7pm.



DAY 14 – THURSDAY APR 7, 2022
AOMORI
DOCKED: 7AM TO 6PM

Ship arrives in Aomori Port at 7am today and you will be picked up at 8am to join a half day tour. We first visit the Furukawa Fish Market, which is Aomori City's largest market and undoubtedly the best place to sample regional seafood, particularly as the market uses an innovative voucher system to entice visitors into trying the delicious fish. Following which we visit the Nebuta Museum Wa Rass, a facility that introduces the history and charms of the Nebuta Festival. You will be transferred back to pier at 1pm and ship departs at 6pm.

DAY 15 – FRIDAY APR 8, 2022
AT SEA

DAY 16 – SATURDAY APR 9, 2022
YOKOHAMA – TOKYO CITY CENTER (L)
ARRIVAL: 8:30AM

We arrive back to Yokohama Port today at 8:30am, and you will be picked up at 9am to join a full day tour with lunch. We first visit the Toyosu Market, opened on October 11, 2018 on the man-made island of Toyosu in the Bay of Tokyo. It took over the wholesale business from the aging Tsukiji Market and provides tourists with an opportunity to observe the market action and to dine at restaurants across its large, modern premises. We then visit the Asakusa Senso-ji Temple, the must-see Temple combines architecture, centers of worship, Japanese gardens. After, we stroll to the Nakamise Arcade, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional local snacks and souvenirs for centuries. Afternoon we will make a photo stop at the Tokyo Sky Tree, a television broadcasting tower which became the tallest tower in the world since 2011. Then we continue to make a photo stop at the Imperial Palace, home to the Emperor of Japan and his family, located on the former site of Edo Castle, a large park area surrounded by moats and massive stone walls in the center of Tokyo. Enjoy a Taiko Drumming experience in the evening, and you will be transferred back to the pier at around 6:30pm or 7pm. Ship will dock overnight in Yokohama Port today, and the rest of the evening is at your leisure.

DAY 17 – SUNDAY APR 10, 2022
YOKOHAMA – HANEDA AIRPORT – DEPART TOKYO

Disembark today and transfer from Yokohama Port to Haneda Airport for your onward flight home. Board your flight from Tokyo to Toronto, and you will be transferred from Toronto Airport back to your home.

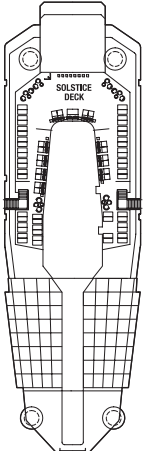

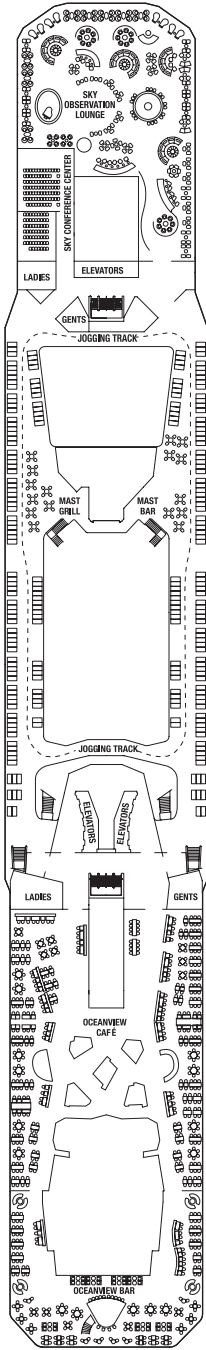

DECK PLAN

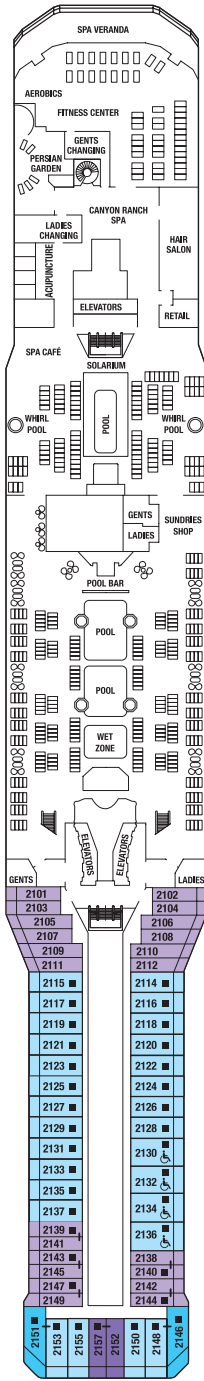
Deck 16 Solstice



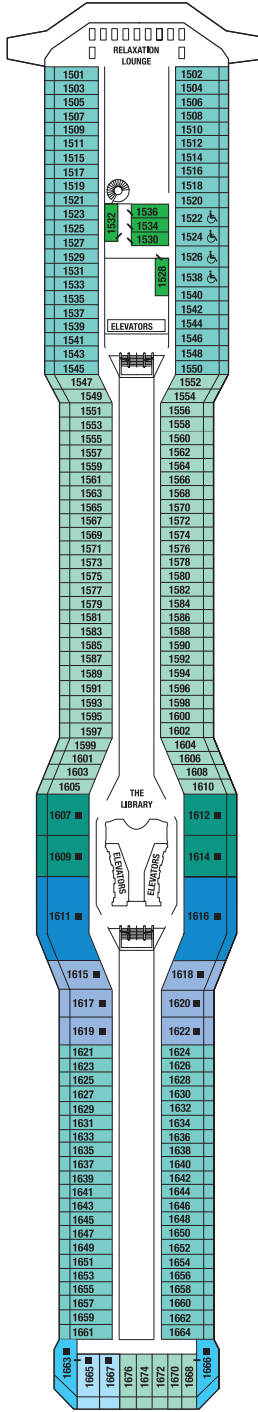
Deck 14 Lido



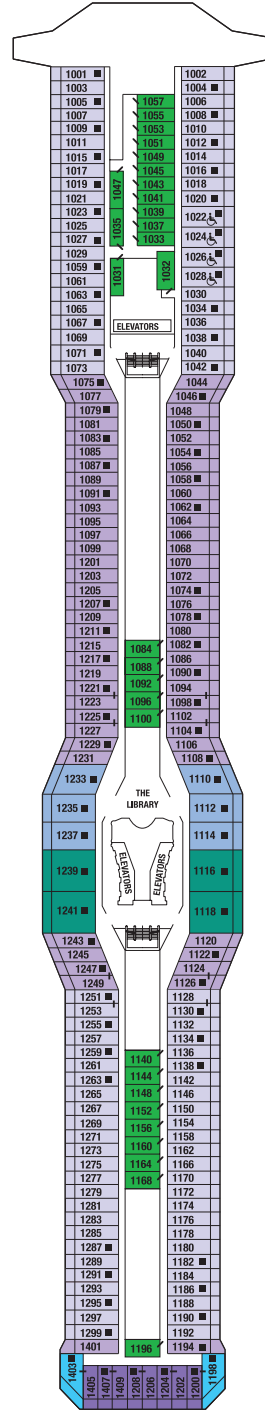
Deck 12 Resort



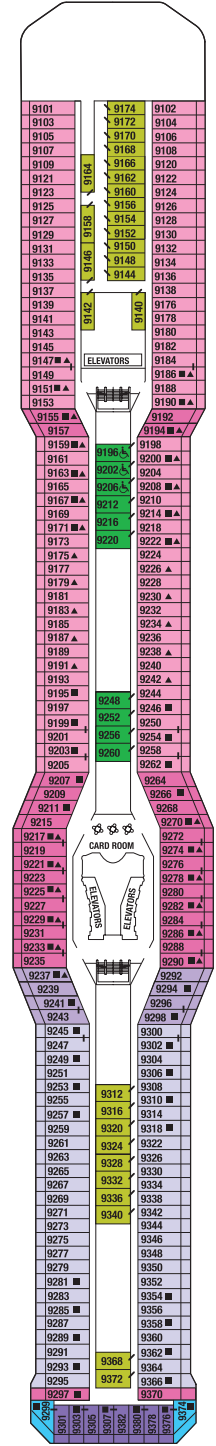

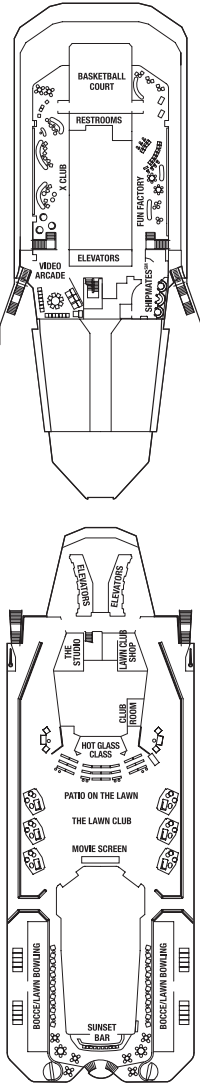
Deck 10 Sky
