

ITINERARY

DAY 1 – SATURDAY MAR 25, 2023 DEPART CANADA – TOKYO

You will be picked up from your home and transferred to Toronto Pearson Airport for your flight to Japan.

Tentative flight: AC 1 25MAR Toronto – Tokyo Haneda 130P 330P 26MAR

Note: Air schedule will be available 11 months prior to departure and flight details will be advised at a later stage.

DAY 2 – SUNDAY MAR 26, 2023 HANEDA AIRPORT – TOKYO (D)

Upon arrival in Haneda Airport, transfer to Tokyo hotel and enjoy the remaining day at leisure. Dinner at hotel.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel Metropolitan Edmont or similar (2 nights)

DAY 3 – MONDAY MAR 27, 2023 TOKYO (B/L)

After breakfast, you will be picked up at hotel at in the morning for a full day tour with lunch visiting Tsukiji Fish market, Asakusa Kannon Temple, Nakamise Arcade, a photo stop at Tokyo Sky tree and Imperial Palace, and Taiko Drumming experience in the evening.

DAY 4 - TUESDAY MAR 28, 2023

TOKYO – YOKOHAMA / EMBARKATION (B) DEPARTS: 7PM

Enjoy breakfast at hotel in the morning and you will be transferred to Yokohama Port for embarkation after check out. Celebrity Solstice leaves Yokohama port at 7pm.

DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY MAR 29, 2023 AT SEA

DAY 6 - THURSDAY MAR 30, 2023

AOMORI

DOCKED: 8AM TO 5PM

Ship arrives in Aomori Port at 8am today and you will be picked up in the morning to join a half day tour. We first visit the Furukawa Fish Market, which is Aomori City's largest market and undoubtedly the best place to sample regional seafood, particularly as the market uses an innovative voucher system to entice visitors into trying the delicious fish. Following which we visit the Nebuta Museum Wa Rasse, a facility that introduces the history and charms of the Nebuta Festival. You will be transferred back to pier in the afternoon and ship departs at 5pm.



DAY 7 – FRIDAY MAR 31, 2023 HAKODATE (L)

DOCKED: 8AM TO 5PM

Ship will dock at Hakodate Port at 8am today, and you will be picked up in the morning to join a full day tour with lunch. We first visit the Motomachi Churches District which showcases a beautiful exotic townscape with Westernstyle buildings and Hachimanzaka Slope. We visit the observatory deck of the Goryokaku Tower which will give you a great overview of the city, and then take the Mt. Hakodate's Ropeway to get a spectacular evening view before returning to the ship. One way Hakodate Ropeway ticket is included. Transfer back to pier and the ship departs at 5pm.

DAY 8 - SATURDAY APR 1, 2023

AT SEA



DAY 9 – SUNDAY APR 2, 2023 BUSAN, SOUTH KOREA (L)

DOCKED: 8AM TO 5PM

Ship docks at Busan Port at 8am today and you will meet your guide at the terminal gate to join your full day tour with lunch.

We will visit the Haedong Yonggungsa Temple. Strategically set along the city's eastern coast, it is the perfect place to catch a spectacular view of the red sun rising through the horizon to brighten the day. Then we proceed to the Oryukdo Skywalk, a 15-meter glass bridge set up over a 35-metre high coastal cliff. Look under your feet to see the soaring coastal cliff and the rhythmic waves and feel like you are walking over the sky!

We proceed to Gamcheon Cultural Village after lunch at local restaurant. Formed by colourful houses built on the foothills of a coastal mountain in a staircase-fashion, it is affectionately nicknamed Korea's Machu Picchu or Korea's Santorini. If time permits, we will experience Busan's rich culture on this journey to the UN Memorial Cemetery. Established in 1951, the quiet park and cemetery honors a total of 2,300 United Nations soldiers representing 16 countries who were killed during the Korean War. You will be transferred back to Busan Port late afternoon and ship departs at 5pm.

DAY 10 – MONDAY APR 3, 2023 AT SEA

DAY 11 – TUESDAY APR 4, 2023 HIROSHIMA (L)

DOCKED: 8AM TO 5PM

Ship will arrive in Hiroshima Port at 8am and you will be picked up in the morning to join a full day tour with lunch. We will first visit the Miyajima / Itsukushima Island, which is one of the most beautiful sites in Japan known for its forests, ancient temples/shrines, and famous for its giant torii gate which at high tide seems to be floating on the water. The sight is ranked as one of Japan's three best views. It is not only an UNESCO World Heritage Site but also designated as National Treasures by the Japanese government. Afterwards your journey continues to iconic landmarks including the Atomic Bomb Dome and the Hiroshima Peace Memorial park.

A tranquil spot covering over 120,000 square meters, it serves to memorialize the great many lives lost in the world's first nuclear attack, while making use of nature to reaffirm the preciousness of all life. Afterwards, you will be transferred back to pier and ship departs at 5pm.



DAY 12 – WEDNESDAY APR 5, 2023 KOBE (L/D)

DOCKED: 9AM TO 10PM

Arrive in Kobe Port at 9am and pick up in the morning for your full day tour with lunch and dinner. Morning visit Todaiji Temple and Nara Deer park. The temple was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all provincial Buddhist temples of Japan and grew so powerful that the capital was moved from Nara to Nagaoka in 784 in order to lower the temple's influence on government affairs.

Afternoon we visit the Nijo Castle, built in 1603 as the Kyoto residence of Tokugawa leyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Period (1603-1867). Afterwards we visit Kyoto's most famous geisha district Gion for a walk, and then have dinner with Maiko performance in evening. Enjoy culture exchange with the performers, and feel free to dress up in Japanese costumes during dinner. You will be transferred back to Kobe port in the evening and the ship departs at 10pm.



DAY 13 – THURSDAY APR 6, 2023 KYOTO(OSAKA) (L)

DOCKED: 8AM TO 11:59PM

Arrive in Osaka port at 8am and pick up at 9am for your full day tour with lunch. Morning visit the Arashiyama Bamboo forest, Japan's most famous bamboo forest and one of the most photographed places in Kyoto. Later we visit the Tenryuji temple, the most important temple in Kyoto's Arashiyama area with its gorgeous Zen garden. Afternoon we will first visit Kyoto's UNESCO World Heritage Kinkaku temple, then the Fushimi Inari Shrine which is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates straddling a network of trails behind its main buildings. You will be transferred back to Osaka port in the evening and the ship departs at 11:59pm.

DAY 14 – FRIDAY APR 7, 2023 AT SEA

DAY 15 – SATURDAY APR 8, 2023 MOUNT FUJI (SHIMIZU) (L)

DOCKED: 8AM TO 5PM

Arrive in Shimizu Port at 8am and pick up in the morning for your full day tour with lunch. Morning visit the Mount Fuji Sth station if weather permits, and enjoy a photo stop at Lake Ashi, before continuing to visit the Mt. Komagatake with Komagatake's ropeway in the afternoon. You will be transferred back to Shimizu port in the late afternoon and ship departs at 5pm.

DAY 16 - SUNDAY APR 9, 2023

YOKOHAMA – HANEDA AIRPORT – DEPART TOKYO ARRIVES: 6:30AM

Disembark today and transfer from Yokohama Port to Haneda Airport for your onward flight home.


Board your flight from Tokyo to Toronto, and you will be transferred from Toronto Airport back to your home.


