DAY 1 / TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2023

DEPART CANADA

Transfer from your home (in GTA area) to Pearson International Airport for your early evening flight from Toronto to Krakow, Poland. Meals will be served in flight.

DAY 2 / WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2023

ARRIVE IN KRAKOW (D)

We arrive in Krakow mid-afternoon and transfer to our hotel for the next three nights. Cited as one of Europe's most beautiful cities, its Old Town was declared the first World Heritage Site. As one of the only cities in the region to survive WWII intact (much unlike Warsaw, for example), Krakow's center is packed with medieval architecture, winding cobblestone streets, interesting museums and sights that make it one of the best cities to visit in Poland. Welcome dinner this evening.

DAY 3 / THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2023

KRAKOW SIGHTSEEING (B, L)

Our morning sightseeing tour is extensive today as we visit the cultural heritage of Krakow. We see Wawel Cathedral, Wawel Royal Castle, St. Mary's Basilica, Saints Peter and Paul church, the Cloth Hall and largest medieval market square in Europe, Rynek Glowny. We also visit Oskar Schindler's factory. Oskar Schindler (1908-1974) was a German entrepreneur and a member of the Nazi party. He is credited with saving approximately 1200 Jews by employing them in his factories so that they could avoid horrible living conditions and eventually death in the Nazi labor camps. A very interesting museum. During our tour you will hear about Karol Wojatyła, archbishop of Krakow, who was elevated to the papacy as Pope John Paul II, the first non-Italian Pope in 455 years. The city hosted World Youth Day in July of 2016. Lunch is included today.

Following our city tour we travel 16 kilometers to the town of Wieliczka where we visit the amazing underground mining corridors of the Wieliczka Salt Mines. At the deepest point we are 135 meters below the surface where there are beautiful chambers carved in salt, including the most exceptional one – St. Kinga's Chapel, as well as underground lakes and unique salt sculptures. Many heads of state and members of royal families have wandered along the nearly 3 kilometers of winding galleries and unanimously proclaim it as one of the wonders of the world.

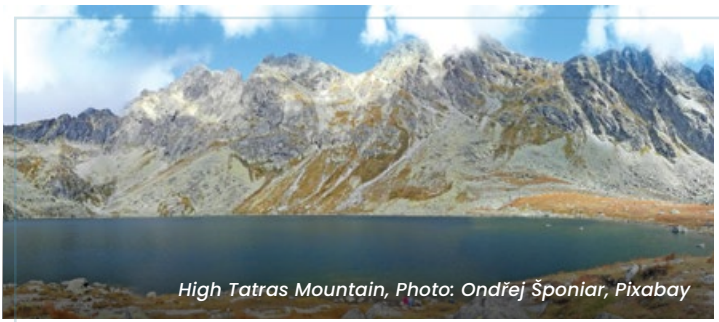
DAY 4 / FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2023

AUSCHWITZ-BIRKENAU (B, L)

We travel about 75 kilometers west of Krakow to the medieval city of Oswiecim. Here we visit the memorial and Museum for Auschwitz-Birkenau, the former German Nazi Concentration and Extermination camps. Auschwitz was the largest of the camps where more than 1.1 million men, women and children lost their lives. The authentic Memorial consists of two parts of the former camp: Auschwitz and Birkenau. The memorial camps are a somber reminder of the darkest part of WWII. Built as extermination camps and partially destroyed by the Nazis at the end of the war to hide their "Final Solution" plans, the camps have been converted into museums and receive over two million visitors every year. There is no way to understand postwar Europe and the world without an in-depth confrontation between our idea of mankind and the remains of Auschwitz. Our visit today with an educator allows a better understanding of this unique place. We will have lunch before returning to Krakow for the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 5 / SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 KRAKOW – STRBSKE PLESO – VIGLAS (B, D)

The Tatra Mountains, highest part of the Carpathian mountain chain in Eastern Europe, create a natural border between Slovakia and Poland. Both Slovak and Polish sides are protected as national parkland and are popular destinations for winter and summer sports. We travel 160 kilometers today to enchanting and scenic Strbske Pleso, enjoy free time to explore and lunch on your own. We continue our journey to the town of Zvolen in the heart of Slovakia. For a special treat we will spend the night at a restored medieval castle, the Grand Castle Hotel Viglas. This combination of Hotel and Castle is a place where history and luxurious service meet. The ever-present feeling of elegance and history is in the medieval surroundings and increases while staying at the castle. Dinner included this evening at our castle accommodation.

DAY 6 / SUNDAY, OCTOBER 01, 2023 VIGLAS TO BUDAPEST, EMBARKATION (B, D)

A relaxing morning to enjoy your breakfast and explore this magnificent hotel before once again joining our coach for the journey to Budapest. Lunch on your own today. This afternoon, welcome to your Danube cruise! Your journey begins in Budapest with an afternoon embarkation on the **MS AMADEUS SILVER III**, a masterpiece of engineering and ship design. It joined the Lueftner fleet in 2016. The ship offers a total of 72 spacious deluxe cabins and 12 AMADEUS Suites. Similar to their other ships, the AMADEUS SILVER III cabins on the Mozart and Strauss Deck also feature lowerable panoramic windows which extend across the entire cabin front and have been specially designed for the

AMADEUS ships. All deluxe cabins and suites offer comfortable, spacious bathrooms, infotainment systems, flat screen television, telephone, cabin safe, minibar and air conditioning which can be individually regulated. This evening, join us for a Welcome Cocktail, followed by a specially prepared Welcome Dinner. A romantic evening cruise through beautifully illuminated Budapest as well as a Hungarian folklore show makes for a perfect beginning to our cruise.

DAY 7 / MONDAY, OCTOBER 02, 2023 BUDAPEST, SAILING TO ESZTERGOM (B, L, D)

Budapest, the “Queen of the Danube”, is one of the most beautiful cities in the world and has managed to retain a charm of its own with the help of renovations in recent years. The Danube flows through the heart of the city, dividing it into two parts: Buda and Pest. **Excursion: Budapest – Capital of Hungary.** The tour first takes you through Pest, past the Great Market Hall with its outstanding gourmet shops and stalls. You will see splendid Baroque buildings such as the Hungarian State Opera in Neo-Renaissance style and the incomparable parliament building, which was finished in 1904 and has been an emblem of the city ever since then. There’s an opportunity for a photo stop at the Heroes’ Square, famous for its monuments to many Hungarian kings. Continue across one of the seven bridges into Buda and go up to Castle Hill, where you will visit St. Matthew’s Church and the famous Fisherman’s Bastion. Enjoy the unforgettable view over the city before returning to the vessel. We depart Budapest after lunch and remain on board to enjoy an afternoon relaxing on deck as our vessel cruises through the Hungarian landscape, before arriving in Esztergom with its famous Basilica. Dinner this evening.

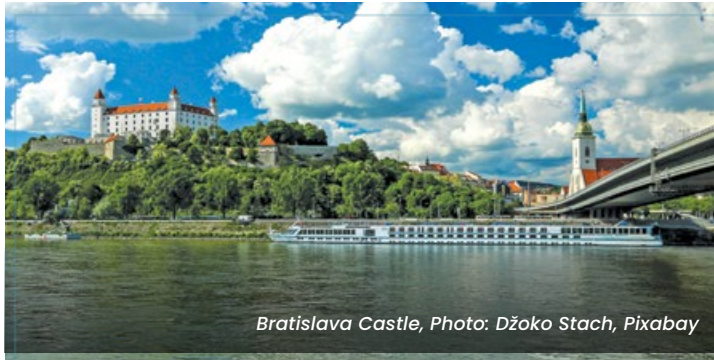
DAY 8 / TUESDAY, OCTOBER 03, 2023

SAILING TO BRATISLAVA (B, L, D)

In the morning, we call at our next capital city – Bratislava. **Excursion: Bratislava – Beauty on the Danube.** Explore the city during our walking tour. See the home of the Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra, the old city walls, the summer residence of the archbishop and the current residence of the president of Slovakia.

Lunch onboard our ship and then in the afternoon enjoy **Excursion: Visit to Schloss Hof Palace and Estate.** An afternoon excursion to visit the impressive Schloss Hof with its aristocratic palace, terraced garden and tranquil estate farm. The palace was acquired in 1726 by Eugene of Savoy and redesigned for the Empress Maria Theresa.

Enjoy dinner onboard as our vessel departs from Slovakia late this evening and crosses into Austria.



DAY 9 / WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 04, 2023

SAILING TO VIENNA (B, L, D)

Breakfast onboard followed by **Excursion: Vienna – Imperial discovery tour.** A tour of imperial Vienna palaces, the Museum Quarter displaying works by artists Egon Schiele and Gustav Klimt, the historic buildings along the Ringstrasse, St. Stephen's Cathedral and the famous Vienna State Opera among others.

Back to our ship for lunch. This afternoon we venture to **Excursion: Visit to Schonbrunn Palace**, the sumptuous summer palace and gardens of Maria Theresia and the Hapsburg Empire. This evening, attend **Excursion: "Sound of Vienna" classical concert.** As the orchestra plays popular pieces from Vienna's classical era. The "Salonorchester Alt Wien", one of the best-known interpreters of classical Viennese music, presents an evening full of Viennese charm with the lilting sound of waltzes, polkas, arias and duets, as well as operetta and piano concert melodies. Accompanied by excellent opera singers and enchanting ballet soloists, Vienna's classical music reveals itself as a living firework display for the senses.

DAY 10 / THURSDAY, OCTOBER 05, 2023

DURNSTEIN TO WACHAU VALLEY TO MELK (B, L, D)

In the morning your ship docks in Durnstein, with its picturesque blue medieval abbey on the edge of the Danube River. Enjoy your free time to wander through this quaint village. Lunch onboard followed by the gorgeous scenery of the Wachau Valley. We enjoy phenomenal views from the upper deck of our ship, steep



vineyard-covered slopes, castles and picturesque medieval towns. The Danube in this part of the world wasn't just a convenience, it was THE way of life. It connected the world in ways unattainable otherwise and it's no exaggeration to say that very stretch of river we enjoy sailing down has been pivotal in the formation of Western civilization. Plus it's pretty, so there's that. We reach Emmersdorf and have an **Excursion: Visit to Melk Abbey.** A tour to the town of Melk with its magnificent Benedictine Abbey – the largest in Austria.

In the evening our ship leaves the Wachau and heads to Linz.



DAY 11 / FRIDAY, OCTOBER 06, 2023

SAILING TO LINZ (B, L, D)

Arrive in the erstwhile cultural capital of Linz, where our vessel makes a short stop for the departure of today's **Excursion: Linz walking tour with Linzer Torte tasting.** The Old Town inspires visitors with the impressive facades of its historic buildings. There is a lively hustle and bustle in the shops, some of which are completely one-of-a-kind. Once primarily an industrial centre, Linz has become a pioneer when it comes to culture, art, and technology. Home to a harbour that doubles as one of Europe's biggest graffiti galleries and the cutting-edge art-slash-technology museum. We continue with a scenic drive to Aschach to rejoin our ship for lunch. Late in the afternoon, the vessel arrives at the confluence of the Danube, the Inn and the Ilz Rivers, the three-river city of Passau. Our "Little Venice" will astonish you from your first moments in its winding streets. **Excursion: Passau walking tour.** In the heart of Old Town lies their most well know site, St. Stephen's Cathedral. Time this afternoon to get ready for this evening as we celebrate at the Captain's Gala Dinner with multi-courses of regional specialities.

DAY 12 / SATURDAY, OCTOBER 07, 2023

SAILING TO REGENSBURG (B, L, D)

Regensburg is one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Germany and its historic buildings are very impressive. Among these architectural treasures are churches, monasteries, the town hall and one of Europe's oldest stone bridges that has spanned the Danube since the 12th century. **Excursion: Regensburg walking tour.** During this walk you will feel the former power and wealth of this city, which once controlled the trade route to the Orient. During our short visit to the Regensburg Cathedral you can admire this masterpiece of Gothic architecture in southern Germany.

Lunch onboard our ship followed by a delightful **Excursion: Thurn & Taxis Castle with brewery and tasting.** The guided tour shows you the beautiful marble staircase in the south wing of the castle, which leads to the magnificent rooms of the Monarchs residence. Guests are traditionally welcomed at the foot of the impressive staircase. The entire neo-renaissance interior is inspired by Roman antiquity. Afterwards you walk to the traditional

brewery at the castle, where you can expect a short tour and have the opportunity afterwards to taste a glass of beer and a typical Bavarian pretzel.

We return to our ship for a traditional Bavarian dinner served as we depart for Passau.

DAY 13 / SUNDAY, OCTOBER 08, 2023

REGENSBURG – PASSAU – CESKY KRUMLOV – PRAGUE (B, D)

After breakfast we bid our ship farewell. We travel by coach 120 kilometers from Passau to Český Krumlov. This medieval town in the Czech Republic is like something straight out of a fairy-tale. A castle clings to the cliffside, cobblestone streets wind past the colourful facades of shops and restaurants where flowers drip out of window sills, and a brilliant blue river meanders through the centre. Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Cesky Krumlov is like a mini-Prague; the same old world charm and beautifully-preserved sites, yet so compact you can walk through the entire old town in less than 20 minutes. The crown jewel of Cesky Krumlov is its colourful hilltop castle and yes, you read that right—there are real, live bears living outside the walls. Time for lunch on your own. Enjoy this little gem of a city. After lunch we continue on to Prague, our home for the next three nights. Dinner included at our hotel this evening.

DAY 14 / MONDAY, OCTOBER 09, 2023 PRAGUE SIGHTSEEING (B, L)

Prague, the Czech capital is known by its medieval old town, sprawling Prague Castle and of course, the iconic Charles Bridge. During our tour you are going to see the most interesting historical sights of Prague. You can admire the Municipal House, Wenceslas Square, the National Museum and Charles Square. It is followed by a ride along the beautiful riverside, across the River Vltava to Prague Castle. There will be 20-30 minutes stop for view and photos and after you will return to the city centre to the Old Town Square where the tour arrives in time to see the workings of the astronomical clock. It is well over 600 years old, one of the oldest functional astronomical clocks in the world, it chimes and gives an animated show every hour. A relaxing lunch is included today before we let you loose to explore this magnificent city.

DAY 15 / TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2023 FREE DAY IN PRAGUE (B, D)

Breakfast at the hotel and then a day to spend at your leisure. Beyond the grand monuments and rich history, there is a rather quirky side to Prague that keeps visitors to the Czech capital on their toes. How about a cocktail served in a garden gnome, riding a paternoster lift elevator that never, ever stops, soak in an entire tub full of ale at one of the city's beer spas and let's not forget the infamous TV Tower, which has been declared one of the world's ugliest buildings and features metal babies crawling up the side. How about dining in a cave at the Adria Hotel in Wenceslas Square, marvel at the Dancing House with a restaurant with a 360 degree view of Prague, shimmy down a 20 inch wide street or hang out on the uber-cool Střelecký Island which is hipster heaven thanks to its food trucks and Pinterest-worthy hangout spaces complete with hanging lanterns and hammocks. More traditional fare is having a stuffed crepe with chocolate and banana from a street vendor or wander into the Jewish centre. A delightful way to relax at a classical concert in Prague that are staged in grand concert halls, Old Town churches, at Prague Castle and in a variety of other magnificent, historic buildings. Make this truly a fun day to remember!

Tonight, we gather for a SPECIAL farewell gala dinner to end our celebrative journey.

DAY 16 / WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2023 FLIGHT HOME (B)

Pack your bags and transfer to airport for our flight return to Toronto. Or add on an optional 3 night Berlin extension if you wish, heading from Prague to Berlin by bullet train.

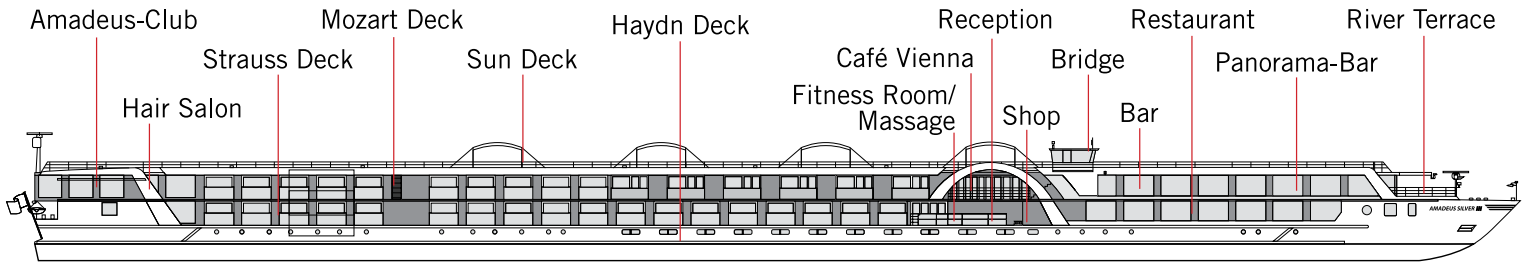

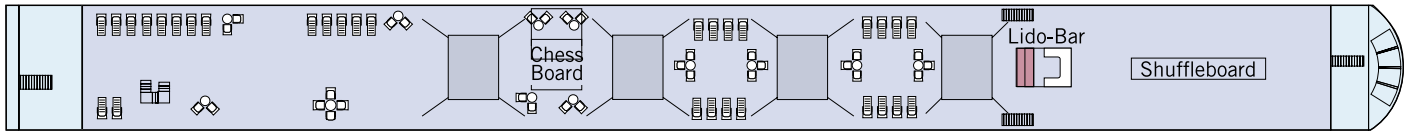


MS AMADEUS Silver III sailing on the Danube / Photo: Lueftner Cruises

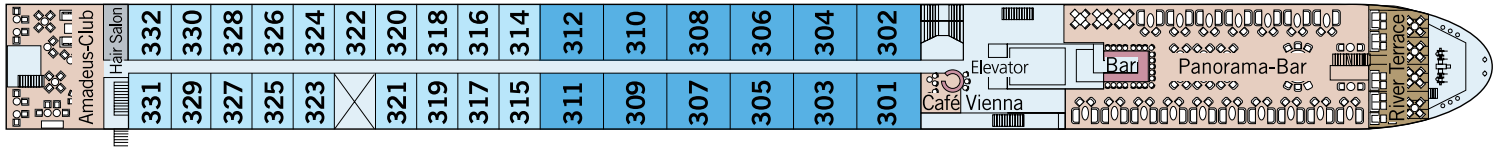
DECK PLAN



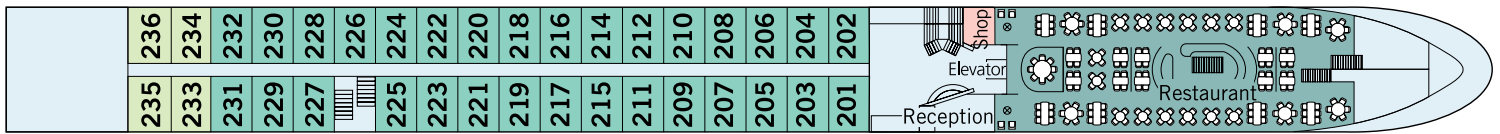
Sun Deck



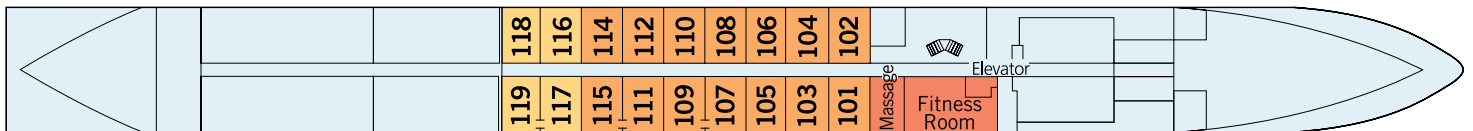
Mozart Deck



Strauss Deck



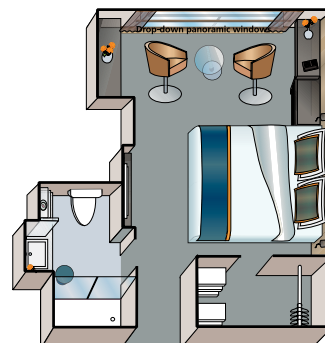
